TULIPS offers a 2-day Grant Writing and Presenting Course (GWPW). This course is based on hand-on workshops combined with interactive sessions and expert opinions, where researchers can receive feedback on their grant application and improve their writing and presenting skills.

Bring your grant to the weekend!

In order to get the best possible feedback, we require participants to bring their personal grant application. Since not all grant applications are similar, we will focus on the following key elements that can be found in the majority of common grant applications.

In case you do not have an active grant application, you can send us a fictive grant application that describes the research you want to perform.

- Name + email applicant
- Aimed grant(s)
- Title (max. 25 words)
- Abstract/ scientific summary (max. 300 words)
- Keywords (max. 5 words)
- Public summary of your research proposal (max. 300 words)
- Description of the research proposal (max. 2000 words)
- Social and scientific relevance (max. 750 words)
- Patient participation (max 250 words)

NB: If you have an original grant application, where these mandatory elements are included following the stated requirements, you are also allowed to submit this. However do realize that all other elements from this grant application will not be covered during the course.
